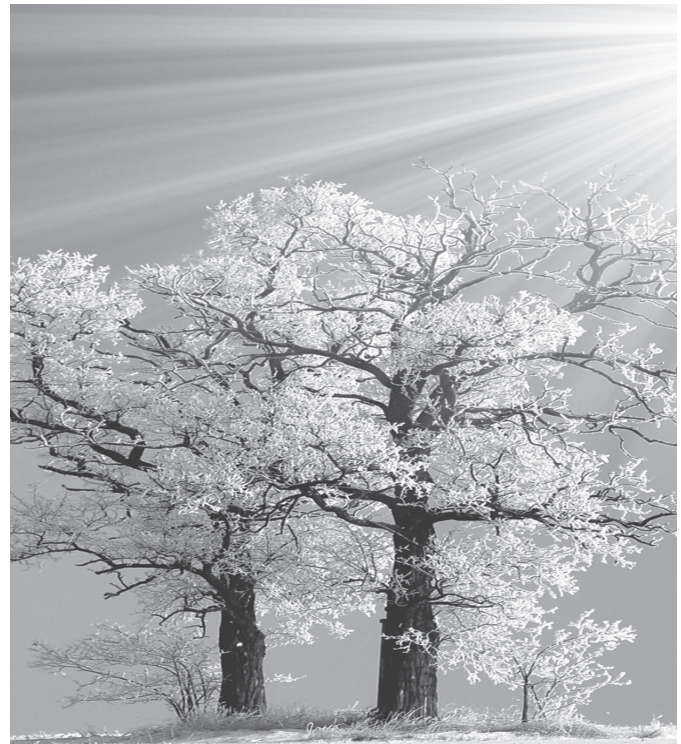

## KNOW YOUR FAITH. . . .

### **Why do our popes write encyclicals, and what do they mean for us?**

In imitation of Saints Peter and Paul, popes have written letters to instruct the Christian Community in the practice of the faith. In the early Church, the Bishop of Rome (the Pope) would write individual letters to one bishop who would circulate them to other bishops.

With the printing press coming into general use, Pope Gregory XVI sent letters (now called encyclicals) to the whole Church. Since 1740 popes have written almost 300 encyclicals.

Unlike Sacred Scripture, **encyclicals are** not divinely inspired. They are, however, **regarded as instruments of the Magisterium which contain the authentic, authoritative teaching of the Vicar of Christ.**

**All Catholics of good will are obligated to acknowledge the apostolic authority of encyclicals and strive in humility to assent to their teaching.**

Pope Pal VI's 1968 encyclical "**Human Vitae**" told Catholics to avoid using artificial birth control. "**Human Vitae**" is considered definitive teaching of the Church, and its precepts are found clearly stated in the **Catechism of the Catholic Church** CCC: 1664, 2366-2379 & 2399.
