## The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 15, 2015 **Know Your Faith** Many mysterious Signs of Mary's appearing in Revelation 11:19; 12:1-6

God's temple in heaven was opened, and because the <u>Ark of His covenant</u> could be seen in temple. A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under feet, and <u>on her head</u> **queen, with a** <u>a crown of twelve stars</u>. Rev. 11:19

She was with child and wailed aloud in pain as she labored to give birth. Rev. 12:2

Then another sign appeared in the sky; <u>It was a</u> <u>Huge red dragon</u>, with seven heads and ten horns, And onits head were seven diadems. Its tail swept away a third of the stars in the sky and hurled them down to the earth. Then the dragon stood before the woman about to give birth, <u>to devour her child</u> when she gave birth.

<u>She gave birth to a son</u>, a male child, <u>destined to</u> rule all the nations with an iron rod. Rev. 12:5

*Her <u>Child was caught up to God and his throne.</u>* Rev. 12:5

*The woman herself fled into the desert where She had a place prepared by God.* Rev. 12:6

Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: **"Now have salvation and power come,** And the Kingdom of our God<u>And the authority</u> <u>of His Anointed one."</u> Rev. 12:10 Mary is called <u>The Ark of the Covenant</u> it contained the manna desert, which prefigured the Eucharist.

Mary is clothed in garments fitting a

**crown of 12 stars.** Called the Gebirah, the first official of the Royal Court.

Under Jewish law, the mother of the king was the queen. (1Kings 1:16-17, 31) **The 12 stars depict the authority** not simply over **the 12 Tribes of Israel**, but **the kingdom of Christ** ----of heaven and earth.

John is alluding to Psalm 2: 8-9

The huge dragon is obviously the devil who tried to **devour with temptation the child, (Jesus)** Matt. 4:1-11

Jesus is depicted as <u>King, Ruler, and Judge. The iron rod</u> that was in the Ark of the Covenant as the Rod of Aaron.

Jesus ascended into heaven and is seated at the father's right Hand. (Nicene Creed) CCC 663-4

**Jesus has prepared a place in heaven** for us & Mary, His Mary, His mother, His Queen, at His right. 1Kg 2:19 CCC 963-964-965-966, 970.

The Assumption of Mary was documented by the 4<sup>th</sup> century. By the 6<sup>th</sup> century, a feast day.

God's Anointed One is obviously ---Jesus
